Decision: 2006- 818

This is in reference to the **Ti-Tee**, received on August 23, 2006, which you submitted for an official ruling. This is a two-piece tee consisting of a flat, triangular shaped tee peg and an hourglass-shaped top piece connected to the peg with a dowel to allow the tee to remain in the ground after impact.

Please be advised that the tee, as submitted, has been evaluated and it has been determined that it conforms to the Rules of Golf.

This ruling applies only to the sample submitted and any tees manufactured identical to it. This ruling does not apply if there is any change in the design, manufacture, material or construction of this particular tee. If a tee of similar design, with identical markings is acquired from any source and found to fail USGA standards, then conformance status of the tee will be reviewed.

In advertisements of the **Ti-Tee**, you are authorized to make the statement: "**Conforms with USGA Rules.**" Use of the USGA seal or logo, and/or statements such as "USGA Approved" or "USGA Tested" is prohibited.

We are retaining the sample as a record of this decision.

The USGA reserves the right to change the Rules and interpretations regulating equipment at any time.
